This training program is suitable for personnel who are required to plan and supervise confined space operations. Including those personnel who are required to prepare Safe Work Permits for Hazard Assessment, Methods of Work, Rescue Plans and Confined Space Entry Codes of Practice.

This Confined Space Entry Supervisor course will also establish an understanding of the statutory requirements of the federal COHS, Provincial and Territorial OH&S legislations.

We will achieve this through discussion and by participating in corroborative group exercises.

By the end of this Confined Space Entry Supervisor course you will be able to:

- Understand confined space characteristics and classifications.
- Understand and apply the company code of practice.
- Undertake hazard/risk assessments for confined space entry.
- Develop safe work permits.
- Select and install control measures.
- Understand the mechanism of atmosphere testing.
- Implement emergency plans and procedures.
- Understand maintenance of records requirements.
